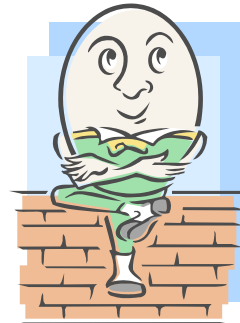
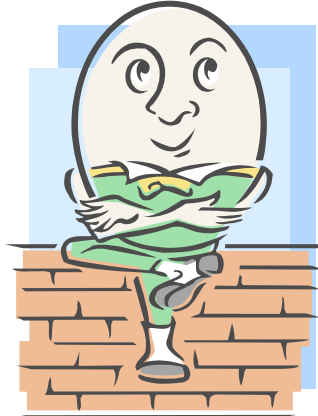

# So what do I really do?

**ON A GOOD DAY:** Mayor's Cabinet; WHEPP; SHSGP; SE WI Port Collaborative; CG Maritime Security; ARC Mass Shelter; NHSC; SE WI UAWG; SE WI IMT; USPS full scale; Mitchell Airport full scale; SCIP; SE WI WEM; AmeriCorps; coordinate training for HazMat, Bomb Squad, Dive Team, HURT, STAC, ESponder; work with DSN, NML, WE Energies, MMSD; conduct outreach/preparedness with individuals and COOP for businesses, FBOs, CBOs; BioWatch; County Grounds EAP; Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan; EMI; NEMA; NHSC; VOAD; manage DHS/FEMA grant programs ; FEMA V DAT COE; update City of Milwaukee CEMP

**ON A BAD DAY:** activate EOC; coordinate response; manage short and long term recovery operations; collect documentation for possible request for Presidential Disaster Declaration

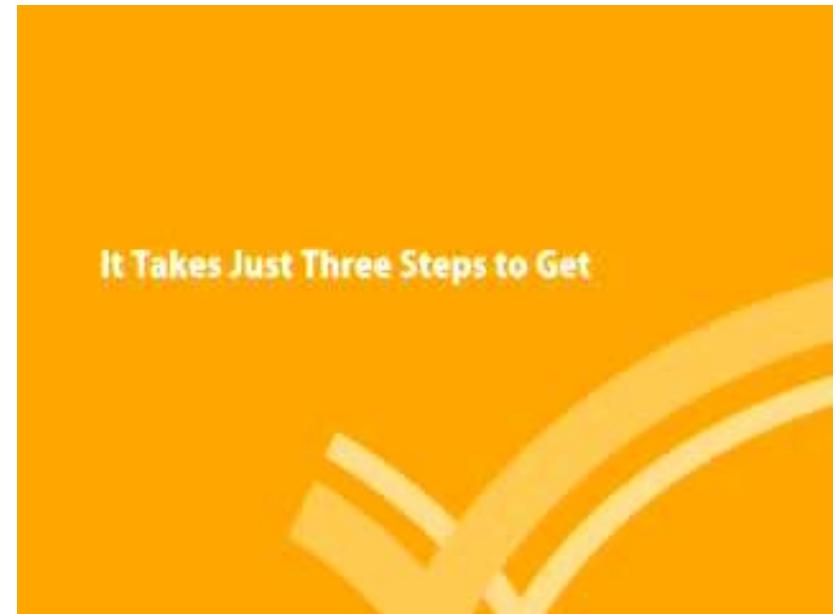

# Plan to Stay in Business

- Small businesses employ more than 50% of private sector workers and provide nearly 45% of the nation's payroll, yet are the most likely to be unprepared to deal with disaster
- It's not that hard to be prepared and there are resources, templates and organizations that are available to help you

# Volunteer

- City of Milwaukee is partnering with CDBG, AmeriCorps and American Red Cross
- We screen & train volunteers pre-emergency
- Participate in 12 hours of training and service over 6 month period to become qualified
- Flexible hours (days, evenings, weekends)
- Actual service (post-emergency) NOT mandatory
- You are not required to serve if an emergency takes place unless you choose to do so



# How to Volunteer

- Sign up today as a prospective volunteer
- We send you more information regarding possible training and service
- You decide where and when train and provide a 12 hours of service during the next six months
- When an emergency arises you will be contacted via phone or email by my office or Red Cross
- You then decide if you can serve (or not) and are given options for volunteer service
