THE PROGRAM

The Rotary Club of Milwaukee (RCM) Scholarship Program is based in a holistic approach to serve students who have the motivation and drive to seek higher education. In addition to a financial award, scholarship recipients receive the support of two mentors.

RCM mentors give guidance, career and personal advice, and help in navigating the college experience. They are the program's greatest resource and are committed to building a supportive relationship with their scholars.

The amount of a financial aid is determined on an annual basis. Recent awards have ranged from \$2,000 and \$4,500 per academic year. With satisfactory academic achievement, scholarships may be continued for RCM Scholarship throughout their program of study.

GUIDELINES

There are no specific requirements for academic achievement, but applications must have achieved a GPA that will qualify them for entry into an appropriate institution or have a record of satisfactory progress toward a post-secondary degree.

Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

Applicants must fill out the application in full, include letter(s) of reference, and submit an original essay discussing the career direction they are considering and stating how the intended college program will contribute to the attainment of that career objective.

To be eligible, students must be Milwaukee residents.
